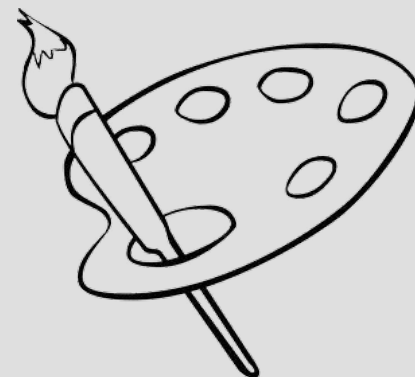


Year 11 Art, Craft and Design
